- Remains informed of the activities of the Gallery Shop and Art Sales and Rental.
- In coordination with other Executive members:
 - Organizes an annual fundraising event
 - Organizes speakers on art-related topics (these events are open to the public and usually held in the afternoon)
 - Recruits Executive members
 - Remains informed of AGG exhibitions and programs
- Gives a yearly report to the AGG's membership at the Annual General Meeting in October. This report covers the activities of the Volunteer Association throughout the previous year.
